COVID-19 At-Risk Patients



Some of our patients are at higher risk for getting sick from COVID-19. At-risk patients include:

- Heart Disease
- Lung Disease
- Kidney Disease
- Diabetes
- Undergoing Chemotherapy
- HIV or other immune disorders such as Lupus and Rheumatoid Arthritis
- Long-term use of Prednisone or other immunosuppressive medications
- Organ transplantation recipient
- Absence of spleen
- Pregnancy
- Over 60 years old

If you are an at-risk patient visiting an IHA practice or Urgent Care location, please follow these steps upon arrival:



Do NOT enter the building. Instead, stay in your car.

- 2 Call your practice and inform reception you have arrived for your scheduled appointment or wish to check-in if at an Urgent Care location. Inform the practice that you are an at-risk patient. You may also request a mask at this time.
- 3 The practice team will contact you at the phone number you provide, or come out to the parking lot when your exam room is ready.



Do not touch your face and use hand sanitizer or wash your hands upon leaving your appointment.

To keep all patients safe, please do not enter an IHA facility if you have any of the symptoms of COVID-19, including, fever, cough and shortness of breath.
