What changes are happening to the Henderson Wellness Clinic?

The Henderson Wellness Clinic is joining the Trinity Health Family. With this transition, we will be relocating to a new space across the street from the Trinity Health Oakland Hospital in the Woodward Professional Building.

Why is this change taking place?

By relocating, we are taking the opportunity to update our facilities for more efficient patient care. The Woodward Professional Building has convenient parking and improved way-finding to our new location. The relocation will also allow for additional opportunities for growth in the future. By joining Trinity Health, expanded services will be available to the communities we serve.

How do these changes impact existing patients?

Patients will maintain connectivity with their existing providers. Expanded services include:

- Access to the MyChart patient portal, allowing patients to communicate with their providers, request prescription refills, ask a medical question, eCheck-in, and pay co-pays and bills online.
- Online appointment scheduling
- Increased point-of-care services (ex. rapid flu, strep and COVID-19 testing)
- On-site blood draws
- Access to and coordination of care with IHA Medical Group specialists
